GPFL's core business is to grow a sustainable and economically viable yield of hardwood. This is a commercial forestry investment and involves the establishment, maintenance and harvesting of plantations within the Green Triangle Region of Victoria.

GPFL endeavour's to maintain their properties so that their neighbours are the least impacted. Some of the ways we do this is by actively maintaining fire breaks around and within our properties and conserve native vegetation and wildlife corridors for the benefit of native flora and fauna.

We will ensure active, ongoing and timely communications with neighbouring landowners by:

- Informing the neighbours and key stakeholders of key planned forest operations, that may affect them;
- Transparently explaining the detail of our Forest Management Plan with interested neighbours or stakeholders following a reasonable request and with suitable notice. For legal reasons, information that may be commercial in confidence may not be disclosed;
- Liaising with neighbours and responding appropriately on issues of concern;
- Providing access to GPFL Representatives.

GPFL aims to establish and build good relationships with people who live near or in the locations that we operate. We encourage neighbours to communicate directly with GPFL Representatives to obtain information or discuss concerns.

GPFL will place a range of documents on its website to assist in providing neighbours and stakeholders information about its business, operations and management intent.
